Borobazar College - A Profile

In 2005, Borobazar College was established in Bijni Town. Formerly known as Reimalie Academy Degree College, it was operated by the Reimalie Society, founded by Mr. Rajen Basumatary as a pioneering venture. However, in 2014, the college relocated from Bijni Town to Borobazar, situated 15 km north of its previous location.

In 2012, Reimalie Degree College gained affiliation with Gauhati University. Following its move to Borobazar, the college withdrawn its affiliation with Gauhati University and obtained affiliation with Bodoland University in 2015. A significant milestone occurred in the college's history with the signing of an agreement between President Mr. Prabin Kumar Brahma of Borobazar Welfare Committee and Chairman Mr. Rajen Basumatary of Reimalie Society. This agreement placed the college under the guardianship of Borobazar Welfare Committee, a move aimed at serving the interests of the local community.

Subsequently, a new Governing Body was established, with Mr. Pamesh Basumatary as president. To better reflect its new identity and serve the local populace, Reimalie Academy Degree College was formally renamed as Borobazar College through an affidavit in 2016.

COURSE DESCRIBTION FOR FOUR YEAR U.G. COURSE FOR 1ST & 2ND SEMESTER UNDER BODOLAND UNIVERSITY AT BOROBAZAR COLLEGE AS PER NEP 2020

There is no separate Major Course and General Course structure in Bodoland University under NEP-2020 in 1st and 2nd Semester. All the students must have to study with above mentioned course structure both in 1st and 2nd Semester. Above mentioned MAJ01, MIN01, IDC01, AEC01, SEC01 and VAC01 are only paper code and paper names. Major Papers carries 100 marks (4 Credit), Minor Paper carries 100 Marks (4 Credit), Inter Disciplinary Course carries 50 marks (3 Credit), Ability Enhancement Course carries 50 marks (2 Credit), Skill Enhancement Course carries 50 marks (3 Credit) and Value Added Course carries100 marks (4 Credit). The same papers have to study in 2nd Semester as MAJ02, MIN02, IDC02, AEC02, SEC02 and VAC02 with same marks and same credits.

All the students must have to select form the following subjects as MAJ01, MIN01, IDC01, AEC01, SEC01, VAC01 in 1st Semester and the same subjects must have to study as MAJ02, MIN02, IDC02, AEC02, SEC02 and VAC02 in 2nd Semester. All the students are asked to select Inter Disciplinary Course in which subject is not studied in H.S. (Arts/Science/Commerce) Classes though the subject must have to available in that college. It is also mentioned that all students are requested to select separate Major Paper, Minor Paper, Ability Enhancement Course, Skill Enhancement Course, Value Added Course and Inter Disciplinary Courses from the Following Subjects.

<u>Major & Minor Subjects</u>: Assamese, Bodo, English, Education, Economics, History, Political Science, Sociology, Geography.

X. Admission Procedure:

- a) The college is co-educational. The college reserves the right to refuse for admission to any candidate without assigning any reason thereof.
- b) Application for Admission is through "Samarth" online portal
- c) Students are bond to produce their original documents during the time of admission. Applicants must Submit online admission application receipt and enclose the self-attested photo copy of following documents along with the admission form receipt:
 - 1. Admit and Mark Sheet of HSLC and HS/HSSLC examination.
 - 2. Registration/Migration Certificate.
 - 3. Copy of passing certificate from the head of the institution last attended.
 - 4. Students passing the qualifying examination earlier to the current year must submitted gap certificate testifying their activities during the period (in original)
 - 5. Two copies of recent passport size photograph.
 - 6. Copy of cast certificate.
 - 7. A identity proof certificate (voter/aadhar card/pan card)
 - 8. Income certificate

RULES

1. College Time Schedule:

- I. Office timing: from 9.00 AM to 4.00 PM
- II. College follows Bodoland University academic calendar.

2. Expulsion/Suspension:

Certain personality traits and behavioral patterns which will invite expulsion of the student from the college are irregular attendance, lack of application of mind tasks allotted, indiscipline and rowdy behavior disrespect to college authority, staff and rules and regulations.

3. Fines etc. Against Misbehavior:

Any damage of college property done by the students should be replace or repay by the concern students.

4. Rules and Regulations:

- a) Every student should follow the college annual academic calendar wherein attendance, academic progress, home assignment, projects and Dissertations of student's performance will be recorded.
- b) Irregularity from the class may bar to seat at Final semester examination.
- c) Bellow 75% of attendance will be not allowed to appear Final Semester Examination.
- d) No students will be allowed to enter the college premise without identity card and proper uniform.

The college observes national and local holidays as per the Bodoland University academic calendar. The college academic calendar may vary to change on time and situations. In this case notification will be given.

6. Internal assessment/semester Test etc., examinations are arranged twice or as according to Bodoland University guidelines.

- b) Girls: Pink Dokhona with black Blouse/ Pink Suridar with white Payjama and Dupatta/Pink Saree.

- b) In case of loss or missing identity card, the matter should be informed immediately to the office. The concern has to apply for the duplicate identity card for which the fine/charge is applicable against.


SUPPORT SERVICE

Courses of Study (NEP,2020)

- UG programmed can be of 3 or 4 years with multiple exit options with appropriate certification in this period like certificate will be awarded after 1 year, an advanced diploma after 2 years, a degree after 3 years, and a bachelor with research after 4 years.
- Academic bank of credit (ABC) will be created in which digitally academic credit earned by students will be stored through different HEIs and it will be transferred and counted for final degree.
- The curriculum in all subjects has been reduced to its core essentials.
- Through this, they focus on critical thinking, discovery, inquiry, discussion, and teaching based on analysis and holistic learning methods for education.
- Regulator for higher education will be light but tight.
- Focus on E-learning so that they can reduce their dependency on textbook
- Under the new policy education will get <u>6% of GDP earlier it was 1.7%</u> which will definitely boost the education system.
- By the end of 2040, they aimed that all HEIs will become multidisciplinary institutions and each of them will have 3000 or more students.
- In the next 15 years, college affiliation will be phased out.
- At least one large multidisciplinary HEI should be built-in or near every district by 2030.
- Aim to achieve 100% youth and adult literacy.
- NTA will offer a common entrance exam for admission in HEIs.
